DECREE

ARTICLE 1 SURVEY AND GENERAL INFORMATION

For the **academic year 2025/2026**, this University is holding the public competition for admission to the Master's course referred to in the form (hereinafter referred to as "Master Sheet") attached to this call (Attachment n. 1), of which it forms an integral part, where all specific information relating to the procedure is given, and in particular:

- name of the course;
- level;
- duration of the course;
- Department of afference and any collaborations and/ or conventions;
- Coordinator;
- admission requirements;
- methods of selection;
- available places (maximum and minimum number of members for activation of the course);
- deadline for submission of tender documents;
- expected dates and cost of registration;
- possible facilities.

All the information concerning the training objectives, the aims, the didactic organization, the places of performance and the didactic plans of the masters are available in the regulation of operation of the master, which is meant to be recalled, consultable on the page <http://www.unina.it/didactics/postgraduate/masters>.

The University structure responsible for administrative and accounting management is the Department of the course. The administrative office responsible for student careers is the Office of Graduate and Master's Schools (USSM).

ARTICLE 2 REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION

Those who meet the requirements of the attached master sheet are admitted to the course, on pain of exclusion.

Possession of the admission requirement is required upon registration for the course. Therefore, those who obtain the title after the deadline for submission of application



to participate in the selection, provided that by the prescribed deadline for course registration.

Those who are in possession of the diplomas of graduate (DL) old system, as well as of the specialized degrees (LS) and master's degrees (LM) belonging to the classes of degree equivalent to the titles that allow access to the competition according to the table attached to the Interministerial Decrees 9 July 2009 and subsequent amendments and additions, are also admitted.

Taking into account that the minimum requirements for access to master's degrees are established in accordance with the structure of the Italian university system on the three cycles of the Bologna process, which can be consulted, inter alia, at the link <https://www.cimea.it/pagina-qualifiche-del-sistema-universitario>, those who are in possession of degrees obtained at foreign universities declared equivalent, are admitted to the competition, within the meaning of the current legislation, or qualifications that the examination board may declare valid for admission to the Master. In this case, when registering for the course, it will be necessary to be in possession of the declaration of value on the spot of the title held by the Italian representation responsible for the territory in the country to which belongs the institution that issued the title considered equivalent to that prescribed, or the certificate of comparability of the foreign title by CIMEA <https://www.cimea.it>.

The registration of international citizens is subject to compliance with the rules in force and, in particular, to the necessary issue of a national long-stay visa for study purposes. For this purpose, international applicants will need to apply for pre-registration for the issuance of a visa using the UNIVERSITY portal (<https://www.university.it>).

The final decision on issuing a study visa is the exclusive competence of the Diplomatic and Consular Representation and the administrative procedure for issuing and renewing the residence permit remains the responsibility of the Ministry of the Interior.

The Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II may decide at any time **to exclude the candidate from the competition**, with reasoned measure, for failure of the requirements prescribed for admission, as well as for any further cause of exclusion provided for in the call.

The exclusion and the reason for it are communicated to the candidate by electronic means at the address indicated during the application process. To this end, the candidate is also invited to provide a certified e-mail address in his or her application.

ARTICLE 3

APPLICATION FOR PARTICIPATION AND TITLES FOR THE EVALUATION

1. SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

In order to take part in the competition, applicants must, under penalty of exclusion, submit **their application exclusively via the telematic procedure at the internet address** <https://www.concorsi.unina.it/domandeMaster/>



within and no later than deadline indicated in the sheet attached to this notice and follow correctly all the requirements indicated in this article.

After this deadline, the telematic procedure will be automatically deactivated and, therefore, it will no longer be possible to register for the competition.

If, at the **end of the prescribed period**, the number of applications for participation in the competition is equal to or less than the number of places available, on a reasoned request from the Coordinator, it will be possible to reopen the said period once. Such **reopening of the terms of participation** and the consequent postponement of the further dates of the competition procedure will be communicated by **notice** published electronically as prescribed in article 13, which will have the value of official notification, normally within 3 days of the closing date. The telematics application process consists of two stages:

A) The first step is User Registration (steps 1 to 5). In case of user already registered to this procedure, go to the second stage "Step 6"; in case of access with SPID (Public Digital Identity System), go to the second stage "Step 7".

B) The second stage consists of compiling the Participation and related press (steps 6 to 14);

A) First stage - User registration (Steps 1 to 5):

1. Link to the University's website:

2. Select the "User registration" option in case of user not registered to this procedure ⁽¹⁾.

Once the data entry form appears, the candidate should:

3. Providing the required data: it is necessary to provide an ordinary e-mail address (in order to receive the access password and the summary of the data entered) and a certified e-mail (for any administrative communications related to the insolvency proceedings);
4. The procedure will automatically assign a password, which it is recommended to write down, so that you can use it later; click on the "INSERT" button and the summary screen will appear;
5. Click on the "LOGIN" button and follow the instructions of the second phase from **step 8**.

B) Second phase - Filling in the application form and on-line submission (Steps 6 to 14):

6. Link to the website of Ateneo
<https://www.concorsi.unina.it/domandeMaster/>;
7. Select one of the access modes ("Login to System" or "enter with SPID). and enter the required data.
8. Select the "New question" option;

9. Provide for the insertion of data relating to the degree obtained, such as Eligibility requirements for the competition;
10. Select the Master you wish to participate in from the drop-down menu;
11. Provide the data required (in particular, you must indicate whether or not you intend to send to the commission the request form for valuation of titles held), using the form attached to this call;
12. Select whether or not you are disabled and need help;
13. Check the data displayed. To confirm the data entered and forward the application, click on "SUBMIT QUESTION";
14. Select the option "Print Application": the candidate will have to click on the button "Print Application Form". In order to display and store the application if required.

The procedure for registering and submitting an application online can be carried out, 24 hours a day, from any computer connected to the network, with the exception of public holidays during which the above mentioned telematic may be temporarily unavailable for maintenance.

Failure to submit an application within the time limits and in accordance with the procedures set out above shall constitute grounds for exclusion from the competition for admission to the Master.

Requests for participation transmitted in any other way than the online procedure described above will not be accepted and the Administration does not assume any responsibility for any network connection errors or for facts attributable to third parties, by chance or force majeure.

2. PRESENTATION OF THE TITLES FOR THE EVALUATION TO THE COMMISSION

If the candidate has indicated in the on-line procedure (described in paragraph 1, step B - point 11 above) that he wants to send to the commission the module of request for valuation of the possessed titles, he must complete the relevant form attached to this call (Attachment n. 3), sign it and send it, **under penalty of not evaluating the titles themselves**, together with any attachments (**scanned and converted into a single file in .pdf format**), **no later than the deadline and to the e-mail address indicated in the Master Sheet attached to this notice. The subject of the message should bear the words "Invio titoli: Concorso per l'ammissione al Master in (indicate the name of the master you are enrolling) - a.a. 2025/2026".**

If the candidate considers it appropriate, for the purposes of the assessment of qualifications under this competition procedure, to attach non-self-certifiable qualifications, such as theses and publications, please note the following:

- ✓ all documents should be collected in a single PDF file;
- ✓ applicants who hold a degree from abroad must attach to the documentation submitted an official translation in Italian of the title of study, accompanied by legalization and a declaration of value made on the spot by the Italian representation responsible for the territory in the country to which the



institution that issued the title considered to be equivalent belongs required for the purposes of the Commission's validity assessment as set out in this call;

- ✓ The name and surname of the candidate must appear on each publication submitted; In addition, in the case of multiple authors of the same work, the candidate's surname must be highlighted;
- ✓ The publications must be certified, on pain of non-evaluation, in one of the following ways:
 - in photocopy, with an attached declaration substituting of act of notoriety, according to artt. 19 and 47 of the D.P.R. 28 December 2000, n. 445 and subsequent amendments and additions, which attests to its conformity with the original, made at the bottom of the document or attached to it, together with a photocopy of the document of their identity card;
 - by means of a declaration, signed by the interested party/ replacement certification (ex-art. 46 of the aforementioned D.P.R.) produced, in the latter case, together with an unauthenticated photocopy of their identity document.

The statements made in the application form and in the application form for assessment of titles have the value of self-certification (made pursuant to D.P.R. n. 445/2000 and subsequent amendments and supplements) of the titles held as admission requirements and valuable titles, pursuant to this competition notice. Therefore, the candidate will have to provide all the necessary details in order to allow the Administration to make the appropriate changes. Please note that false and untrue statements are punishable under the Criminal Code and special laws on the subject.

The Administration is entitled to verify the veracity of the replacement declarations of certification or acts of notoriety made by candidates, in accordance with the above-mentioned legislation.

In the case of incomplete declarations concerning the qualifications that can be evaluated, the Examining Board is entitled to ask for supplements and/or clarifications from the candidate and/or the Administration in order to admit the self-certified qualification for evaluation.

The Administration does not assume any responsibility for the case of unavailability or dispersion of communications attributable to incorrect indication of address by the candidate, or failure or late communication of the change of address indicated in the application.

ARTICLE 4

SELECTION PROCEDURE

The specific selection information is set out in the attached master sheet, subject to the following general criteria:

1. The selection may be by title or by title and examination.
2. With the exception of the admission of candidates referred to in point 4 below, the Commission has at its disposal 70 points if the selection is for qualifications only and 100 points if the selection is for qualifications and tests, of which at least 60 are reserved for qualifications. **The evaluation of**



the qualifications will precede the conduct of any test and the related score will be announced upon publication of any final merit ranking.

- 3. If an examination is planned, in addition to the assessment of qualifications**, the candidate who has not been informed of the exclusion from the competition as indicated in Article 2 above, must be present on the day, time and place of the test, or by telematic link according to the indications of the master card, with a valid identification document. If the test is held, the absence of the candidate, whatever the cause, will be considered as a waiver. Normally the Administration, at least 3 days before the test date, will publish electronically in accordance with art. 13, a notice that will have the force of official notification containing:
- any changes or additional reports on the test;
 - the list of candidates admitted to the test, if a minimum score is required for the titles;
 - Failure to take part in the test, if there is no minimum score for passing it and the number of participants in the competition is equal to or less than the number of places available.

If none of the conditions listed above is met, NO notice will be published and the candidate must therefore comply with what has been communicated in the master sheet.

The candidate is in any case obliged to consult the portal of Ateneo for all possible communications related to the selection.

- 4.** The selection by qualification or by qualification and examination will be concluded with the formulation of a ranking of merit in the following cases:
- in the case of grants or other award mechanisms for fewer beneficiaries than the number of participants in the competition;
 - in the presence of a minimum score for passing the selection (ai certificates and/or evidence);
 - If the number of applications for participation in the competition exceeds the number of places available;
 - in the presence of a number of applications to participate in the competition with a request for access to the incentive "PA 110 e lode", where provided, higher than the number of quotas established by the Department of reference of the Master's course.

If none of the above conditions is met, selection will not take place and applicants will be automatically admitted to registration provided they meet the admission requirements.

- 5.** The possession of a Bachelor's, or Master's Degree, or Master's Degree in a Single Cycle and any other qualification provided as an admission requirement is not assessed for the purposes of the qualifications. The possible final score of the title itself, like any other title, can be evaluated only if achieved within the deadline for participation in the competition.



ARTICLE 5

EXAMINING BOARD

The Examining Board is appointed, where provided, by rectoral decree and is chaired by the Coordinator and consists of three components, including the Coordinator himself, appointed by the Scientific Council of the Master. At least two of them must be full-time professors and/or temporary researchers from the University of Naples Federico II.

The composition of the above-mentioned commission will be made known in the manner indicated Article 13 of this call.

ARTICLE 6

AUTOMATIC ADMISSION OR FORMULATION OF THE RANKING

Except in the case of **ex-officio admission** referred to in Article 4 above - point 4, **the merit evaluation** will be formulated according to the descending order of the overall score given by each candidate on the basis of the criteria and selection procedures set out in this call and in the attached master sheet.

If two or more candidates score equally, they will take precedence in the ranking the youngest candidate of age.

The Administration, having established the regularity of the competitive procedure, **issues a decree authorizing the ex-officio registration** of candidates in possession of the admission requirements **or a decree approving the final ranking**. In both cases, the decree will be published electronically, as prescribed in article 13, **with notice of registration terms and conditions by the date indicated in each Master Sheet attached to this call, subject to any notice of reopening of the terms resulting in slippage of the dates as provided for in art. 3 paragraph 1 or deferral of publication of the ranking.**

All notices shall have the status of official notification. **No personal communications will be sent.**

From the date of publication to the Official Register, the time limits for possible appeals.

Candidates automatically admitted to enrollment or candidates who are usefully placed in the aforementioned ranking, also as a result of possible slippage, will be admitted to attend the Master's Course, subject to verification of compliance with the admission and registration requirements.

Candidates admitted to the enrollment subject to obtaining the diploma of degree earn the right to enroll in the course only in case of achievement of the same title by the date prescribed for the enrollment.

ARTICLE 7

AMOUNT OF REGISTRATION FEE

The registration fee for the Master's course, including the insurance cost of the



participants, the method of payment of the contribution itself, stamp duties and regional tax for the right to study at university are shown in the form attached to this call.

Any facilities or economic benefits to cover all or part of the registration fee, in favor of the winners in order of ranking or admitted of office to the master, are indicated in the master sheet attached to this call and will be communicated to the beneficiaries in the registration notice referred to in art. 6 above.

ARTICLE 8 **SUBSCRIPTION OF CANDIDATES ADMITTED AUTOMATICALLY OR OF THE WINNERS**

The candidates admitted automatically or winning results must provide for the registration to the course of Master, under penalty of exclusion, **by the deadline and according to the procedures prescribed for the registration in the notice referred to** above article 6, by means of the payment procedure described in the Annex to the notice.

Applicants who do not have an account registered at the University must log in to the payment portal with the tax code and password chosen during re-registration, or through SPID.

Applicants who already have a university account must log in to the payments portal with their tax code and the password of the institutional mailbox of Ateneo of the type name.surname@studenti.unina.it, or through SPID.

Candidates admitted to the Master's course and holding degrees from foreign universities, must produce at the time of registration the declaration of value in loco of the title held by the Italian representation responsible for the territory in the country to which belongs the institution that issued the title considered equivalent to the prescribed, or the certificate of comparability of the foreign title by CIMEA <https://www.cimea.it>.

Please note that the payment of taxes and fees alone does not constitute registration.

The Administration can also provide after registration to verify the veracity of self-certification submitted by applicants, proceeding to the following steps.

Admitted candidates who have not finalized the registration by the deadline will be considered as renouncers and will proceed to the scrolling of the ranking according to the following article.

ARTICLE 9 **REGISTRATION OF ELIGIBLE PERSONS**

Vacancies resulting from withdrawal or non-registration by the winners will be made available to eligible candidates in the order of the final ranking. To this end, the Office of Graduate and Master's Schools, in the notice referred to in previous article 6, will indicate the date on which the possible scrolling of the ranking will be communicated.

The number of vacancies, the names of those entitled to registration, the deadlines



for registration shall be notified in the notice of vacancy, if any, published in accordance with the procedures set out in Article 13 below, as well as the date on which any further scrolling of the ranking will be communicated.

Candidates who have acquired the right to enroll following the above ranking shall, on pain of exclusion, send to the Office of Graduate and Master's Schools, within the peremptory deadline indicated in each notice referred to in the preceding paragraph, the same documentation required of winners as described above. After the deadline indicated in each notice, those who have not made the registration will be considered as renouncers.

ARTICLE 10

SIMULTANEOUS REGISTRATION

Pursuant to current legislation and in particular under the Law of 12 April 2022 n. 33 and of the D.M. n 930 of 29 July 2022, it is possible to simultaneously enroll in a course of university master's degree and another course of university study in the cases and under the conditions provided for therein. Regarding the possibility of simultaneous enrollment in the course of master and doctoral research, or master and specialization, it is specified that the same can be accepted after obtaining the favorable opinion of the collegiate bodies of both courses, which will assess whether or not the conditions for acquiring the knowledge and skills necessary to achieve the training objectives of each course are met. The student is responsible for the effective sustainability of the simultaneous attendance to all didactic and training activities of both courses. In any case, the student will still be able to use, if provided for, the institute of suspension of studies.

ARTICLE 11

DURATION AND ORGANISATION OF THE MASTER

For the duration, the distribution of the activities of the Master, the didactic plan and the procedures for carrying out the periodic verifications and the final test are referred to the Rules of operation of the Master that is intended to be recalled. The timing and delivery of activities will be made known by each Coordinator.

ARTICLE 12

ALLOCATION OF THE FINAL TITLE

In order to obtain the final degree, the student must have acquired the credits provided for by the current regulations governing the attended course, including those relating to internship activities and the final test. The achievement of credits is subject to periodic verifications of acquired skills with possible evaluations.

The final examination commission is composed of an odd number of at least five members, including the coordinator who chairs it, appointed by the Scientific Council, whose majority must be chosen from among professors and researchers of the University.

The committee shall cast its final vote in one hundred tenths and may, by unanimity, give the praise. The minimum score for passing the final test is 66/110.



ARTICLE 13 **PUBLICATION OF DOCUMENTS**

This competition notice and all related documents will be made public exclusively through publication in the Official Computer Register of the University of Naples Federico II, present on the University website www.unina.it. This publication is an official notification for all purposes and no personal communications will be sent to the interested parties.

ARTICLE 14 **ACCESS TO DOCUMENTS, PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA AND RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PROCEEDINGS**

Applicants are guaranteed access to procedural documents competitive, in accordance with the current legislation.

This right will be exercised in accordance with the procedures established by the current University Regulation on administrative procedure and the right of access to documents issued by Rectoral Decree n. 4522 of 11.11.2022.

Personal data and special categories of personal data, which this Administration comes into possession under this procedure, will be processed in accordance with the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679, the Code on the protection of personal data, (Legislative Decree n. 196/2003 supplemented and amended by Legislative Decree n. 101/2018), as well as the University Regulation on the protection of personal data (issued with D.R. n. 1226/2021). The data collected will be processed for the purposes of this procedure for which they are issued and will be used exclusively for this purpose and, in any case, within the institutional activities of the University of Naples Federico II. The data subject is entitled to the rights set out in Articles 15, 22 and 77 of the EU Regulation.

The Head of the Office for Master's and Specialization Schools at the University of Naples Federico II is responsible for all matters relating to this competition procedure that are not within the competence of the examination committee.

The above-mentioned person may assign in writing to another employee of the organizational unit responsibility for procedural compliance.

ARTICLE 15 **FINAL PROVISIONS**

For everything not expressly provided for in this call, reference is made to the current legislation.
